MIC Terms and Conditions

MIC Online System

1- The duration of the MBA, EMBA and MPA Online programs is 16 months. Throughout this period, 15 courses are offered and one month is allotted to students to finalize a Research Project.

2- Every month or every semester (depending on the courses) a new subject is offered, and a new professor assigned. Professors establish direct contact with students by e-mail and monitor their progress.

3- Students can contact professors at any time (24/7 = 24h in 7 weekly days), concerning course materials and other related issues. Therefore, students should monitor their e-mails regularly.

4- Each course will be followed by a monthly or end-of-semester examination.

As the rules are strict at MIC, students are required to complete the monthly or end-of-semester examinations on time, as prescribed by the professors. Late assignments will NOT be accepted.

Once registered, students will fall under the MIC disciplinary

Committee's internal regulation, called "MIC Code of Conduct".

Live Video-Audio Interactive Online System

5- MIC does not send course materials by e-mail. Students are requested to go online, visit our website and download the course materials.

6- To gain access to the course materials every registered student will have a Password and will be able to visit the MIC Online Page. You will also have access to the Student Forum where you will be able to send and receive messages and communicate directly with MIC management, professors and students.

7- A large number of MIC Online courses are sent through an Audio and Video system. Students will be connected to software allowing them to receive Live Audio and Video Courses. Professors will teach online at a specific time. Students from various countries will receive the same course and will be able to communicate with professors and with other students in other countries.

8- The MIC Live Video and Audio Interactive Online system will allow students and professors to have efficient interactive communication. After one hour of teaching, students can ask questions from their professor and receive their answers directly.

9- MIC materials as well as student passwords are sent only to registered students as this information is intended for the use of registered MIC students only.

MIC Tuition Fee

10- Our standard tuition fee for Overseas applicants is 7,000\$US for the entire program. This program is supported by "The MIC Canadian Private Overseas Online Program (MCPOP)".

Our tuition fee for Canadian, American and western European applicants is 10,000 US\$ for the entire program.

Scholarship

11 - The MIC-Canadian Private Overseas Online Program (MCPOP)" awards scholarships to candidates from Asia, Central Asia, Eastern

Europe, the Middle East and Africa for Distance Learning Executive MBA and MPA degrees, on the basis of academic and professional merit. This scholarship would cover between 10%, 20% up to 45% of your tuition fees.

If your application for a full scholarship is approved by the MIC Admission Committee, for 45% of your tuition fees, you will pay only 55% of the whole tuition fee, or 3850\$US.

This amount should be paid in two instalments: one at the beginning of the program and the other one year after. Each payment is 1925US.

Monthly Payment System

12- MIC also offers a Monthly Payment System. This system would allow applicants to pay their tuition fees monthly.

All applicants can apply for a monthly payment.

The monthly payment follows a schedule which will be sent to students once their application is approved by the MIC Admission Committee.

MIC Admission Requirements for the EMBA or MPA Program

To apply for an Executive MBA (EMBA), MBA or MPA at MIC as well as for a scholarship, you must provide us with the following documents:

- Your Resume (CV)
- A copy of your official transcripts of your last degrees after high School
- A copy of all university degrees
- A Recommendation letter from your employer (If Applicable)
- A Recommendation letter (From your previous professor or employer)
- A copy of the first two pages of your passport
- Official GMAT score (This is not obligatory)
- A copy of the TOEFL results, CANTEST, TOEIC or any other English Test (This is not obligatory)

All documents should be translated into English.
You should scan your documents and send us only by e-mail.

Please do not hesitate to write us if you don't have any of these documents.

MIC Scholarship

The Management Institute of Canada Scholarship is offered only for the MCOPO students and for the following Programs:

Executive Master in Business Administration (E MBA Program)
Master in Public Administration (MPA)

If you receive a scholarship you must complete 100 percent of your coursework during each enrolment period. If you receive an award for the academic year but do not complete 100 percent of the coursework during the first semester, your award will be automatically cancelled for the next semester. You may reapply for award consideration in the next academic year.

To be eligible, you must be a citizen or permanent resident of the following countries:

Armenia, Azerbaijan, Albania, Afghanistan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Estonia, Georgia, Iran, Lithuania, Kazakhstan Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Tajikistan, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Russia, Uzbekistan, Slovenia, Ukraine, Yugoslavia

MBA and MPA Fees:

MIC scholarships are offered by our MCPOP (MIC- Canadian Private Overseas Online Program - MCPOP) Program to qualified applicants from the indicated countries to assist students with tuition fees.

MIC Regular tuition fees for the EMBA and MPA programs, for applicants from Canada, the United States and Western Europe are 10,000US\$.

The regular tuition fee for students from Overseas offered by MCPOP is 7,000US\$.

The scholarship covers only a percentage of the tuition fee. (This is not a

full scholarship).

MIC Scholarships cover between 10%, 20% up to 45% of this amount. In case an applicant obtains a full scholarship, means 45%, he or she will only be required to pay 3850US\$.

MIC Monthly Payment System

Applicants from MCPOP Program can also pay their tuition fees monthly. The minimum payment is 241\$ per month.
